Subject: Provision of online Academic Infrastructure for Advanced Technology Courses in YCTCs

Whereas the Joint Council of Education – Partners of Youth Services (JCEPYS), vide communication dated 29.01.2026, has represented that a significant number of Youth Computer Training Centres (YCTCs), particularly in districts outside Kolkata, are facing constraints in terms of availability of trained faculty and adequate training infrastructure for delivering advanced technology-oriented courses;

And whereas discussions were held with M/s Hewlett Packard Enterprise (HPE) regarding provision of a centralized digital academic delivery mechanism to ensure uniformity, quality assurance, and standardization of curriculum delivery and assessment across all YCTCs;

Now, therefore, in the interest of ensuring homogeneous and quality training delivery across the State, the Department of Youth Services & Sports hereby conveys its approval for operationalization of a digital academic support framework to be provided by M/s Hewlett Packard Enterprise (HPE) for implementation of the newly introduced advanced technology courses in YCTCs.

1. Scope of Support:

M/s Hewlett Packard Enterprise (HPE) shall provide:

- Digital learning platform access
- Academic content and instructional resources
- Expert faculty support (as applicable through digital mode)
- Faculty development programmes
- Academic monitoring and support mechanisms

2. Service Fee Structure:

The cost of such digital academic infrastructure and support services shall be a uniform 15% (fifteen percent) of the prescribed course fee per enrolled student, applicable across all approved advanced technology courses.

The said amount shall be payable directly by the concerned YCTCs to M/s Hewlett Packard Enterprise (HPE) as service charges.

3. Condition Precedent for Examination Scheduling :

Payment of the aforesaid 15% service charge to M/s Hewlett Packard Enterprise (HPE) shall be treated as a mandatory pre-condition before scheduling candidates for examination under the EEAS platform.

No candidate shall be scheduled for assessment under EEAS unless confirmation of payment of the applicable service charge has been duly complied with.

4. Implementation :

All YCTCs implementing the approved advanced technology courses shall align with the above framework to ensure standardized academic delivery and quality control across the State.

This order is issued in the interest of maintaining academic uniformity, quality assurance, and employability enhancement of students enrolled in YCTCs.
